This place was where Britain's interest in the South Polar Regions was re-kindled, where the seeds of the National Antarctic Expedition (*Discovery*) and the British Antarctic Expedition (*Terra Nova*) were sown, and where the man largely responsible lived from 1859 until his death in 1916.
